Provided clothing

Laundry facilities

Teaching hours

At most sites there are 15 hours of English teaching each week. This is predominantly weekdays between the hours of 9.15 and 1pm. It is important that classes start promptly, and teaching staff are requested to be in the classroom block ready. Caterham campus has 2 full days of English and one morning.

All materials will be provided for teachers and lesson planning remains crucial. All teachers are required to bring their own laptops with an HDMI Adapter if your laptop doesn't have an HDMI port.

<u>Staff Sleeping Arrangements</u>

Full board accommodation is provided. Accommodation comprises of a single bed, wardrobe and desk. Male and female staff will be in different accommodation blocks or, if in the same block, they will be on different floors. We may be required to move bedrooms during the camp depending on the number of students on site at any one time. There is also Wi-Fi access on campus including in each of your rooms.

Non-residential teachers

Non-residential teachers will be staying off-site. They will be teaching four hours per day for four days each week starting at 9:15 and ending at 1pm. Non-residential teachers are welcome to join us for either breakfast or lunch.
